



Pizza Delivery Robbery Prevention Tips



1. Delivery drivers should not carry more than \$20 in cash.
2. Do not resist, confront or chase a robber.
3. Follow the instructions of a robber. Do not challenge or try to outwit a robber. The robber should not feel that he/she is losing control of the situation. This can motivate them to become more violent.
4. Do not enter the customer's home under any circumstances.
5. **DO NOT MAKE DELIVERIES** to vacant houses, apartments or any place that has suspicious activity about. Use call back procedures after dark. Avoid deliveries to areas of high crime or areas known for frequent drug use.
6. Contact local police if you observe anyone acting suspicious or unusual near a delivery location, then do not make the delivery.
7. If any employee was injured during the robbery, call Hospitality Comp to report the injury, even if immediate medical attention is not required.
